Care for Creation– Mold. Most Careful - If you find water damage in a basement, attic or living space, try to dry the area completely. A fan or two will help within 48 hours. If you have a lot of water, get professional help. They will have powerful vacuums, fans and dehumidifiers to dry quickly and prevent fungal growth. Ceiling tiles, carpeting, wallboard & other absorbent surfaces that get moldy are virtually impossible to clean and must be removed at once to prevent mold from spreading.
